The Agronomy and Veterinary medicine Faculty ([FAMV](#)) is one of the 11 establishments on the divided campus of the Haiti state University, which also owns branches in province.

- Creating intellectual, material and logistical conditions favourable to the realisation of good agronomical education.
- Making sure of the level, content and quality of trainings that young people receives.
- Making them agents of agricultural development of Haiti.
- Being attentive to problems within the agricultural sector.
- Helping by appropriated research programmes propositions to find solutions to these problems.

- Participating to the scientific knowledge and techniques diffusion in order to promote the agricultural sector of the country.
